Fetus: This is the most common sleeping position. People with this sleeping position are strong on the outside but soft at heart. They are shy but warm up quickly.

Log: Sleepers lie on their sides with both arms down. They are social and easygoing, but they trust strangers easily.

Yearner: Yearners sleep on their side with both arms out in front. They are slow to make up their minds, but after they make a decision, they don't want to change it.

Soldier: In this position, people sleep on their back with arms down at their sides. These people are strong and quiet. They take themselves very seriously.

Freefall: These people lie on their stomach with their arms up. They enjoy meeting and talking with people. They would be a little proud. Sometimes, they care too much about what others think of them.

Starfish: Sleepers lie on their back with both arms up. They are good friends and great listeners. They love to help others and they hate being the center of attention.
