

The Internet has brought people closer than ever. It offers people a great way to express their opinions, but sometimes some of them feel just too comfortable to hold back a bit. This is often the time when cyberbullying happens. Cyberbullying hurts just like real bullying, and it may even be more dangerous. That's because those who are bullied online are often bullied in real life as well. What's worse, cyberbullying can take place 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, and it happens just about everywhere on the Internet. That means no one is safe, but it doesn't mean those who are bullied should stop asking for help.



Seeing how serious the problem has become, Twitter decided to change their policy to protect people from being bullied while staying true to their value of free speech(言論自由). They hired more workers to deal with reports of bullying. In the past, they only accepted reports directly from the victims, but that has changed since they realized how narrow their old policy was. Jack Dorsey, the CEO of Twitter, has also been trying very hard to balance free speech and abusive language on Twitter.

Nelson Mandela was once a prisoner but later became the president(總統) of South Africa. His fight for civil and human rights (人權) had earned him worldwide respect.

He was born in 1918. His father died when he was twelve. In 1942, Nelson Mandela joined a group. This group asked for civil rights for blacks in South Africa. At that time, blacks didn't have the right to vote. They could not enjoy the same rights as the whites did. Nelson Mandela and the other people in the group wanted the South African government to give up such a system. The white government did not like their ideas. Many blacks were put in prison, beaten, and even killed. Nelson Mandela was also arrested.

In 1964, Nelson Mandela was put in prison. His health became very bad. By the late 1980s, many fights happened between young black South Africans and the white government. Finally in 1990, the white government agreed to free Nelson Mandela. In 1995, Nelson Mandela became the first Black African president.
