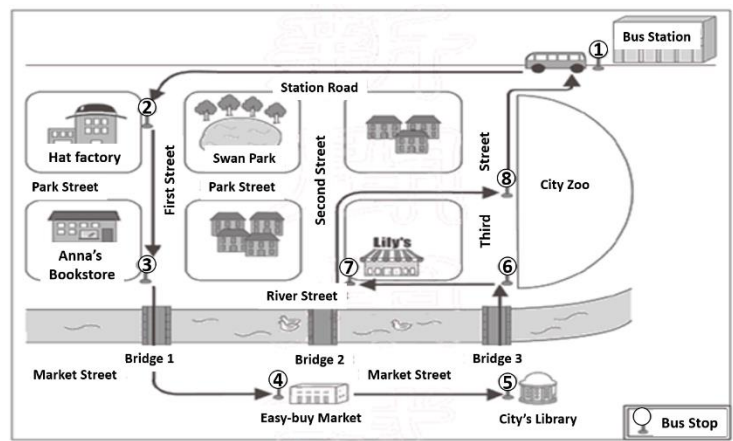

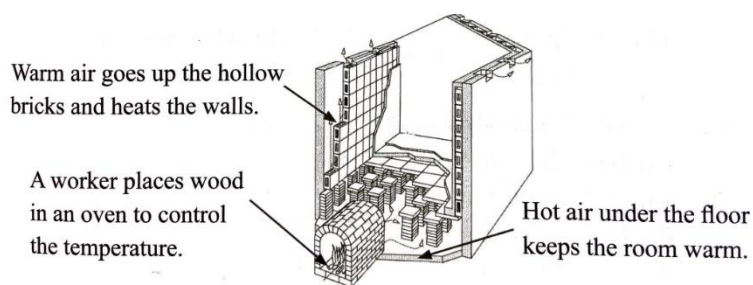
The Romans are bathing every day, but it wasn't always that way. Early Romans did wash their arms and legs often because they would get dirty from work. However, they only washed their bodies every nine days. Sometimes they took a hot bath in lavatrina, a room next to the kitchen. Other time, they swam in the Tiber River to clean up.

By the 2<sup>nd</sup> century B.C.E., things began to change. Romans started to build bathrooms in their houses, and opened the first public bathhouse. This made daily bathing possible for common people around the city. Before the end of the Roman Empire, Rome had almost one thousand public bathhouses.

Bathing needed two important things : heat and water. To bring water into bathhouses and homes, the Romans built huge water-carrying pipes. The plan was a great success for the time. Heat came from a central heating system in the basement. Romans called this system a hypocaust. Because it needed a lot of people to work on, hypocausts could only be found in the homes of rich people and public bathhouses.
