What Is the Placebo Effect?

A placebo is something that looks like real medicine, but it is not even medicine. It is not real medicine, but it can still make some people feel well.

Why Do Placebos Work?

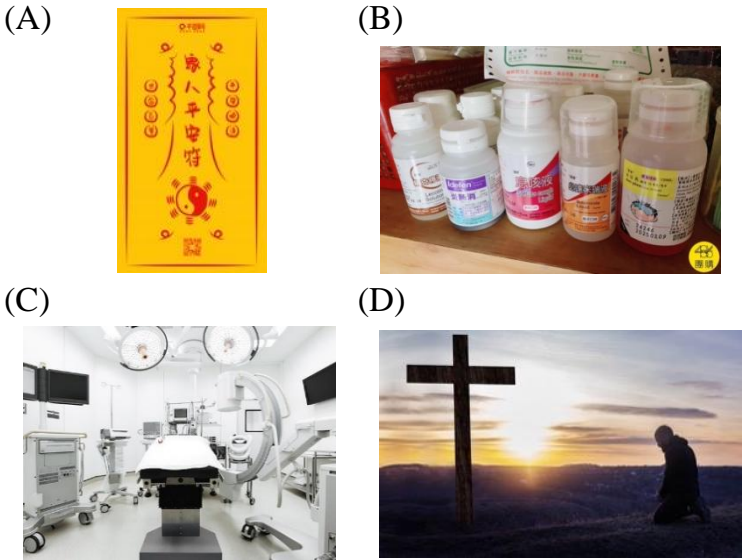
The answer comes from the brain. When people believe the medicine is real, the brain can help the body feel good. Even it is only some sweet drinks. The brain may even help stop pain, and then people will find it easy to take some rest and sleep. In fact, a happy brain can sometimes help a sick body feel strong.

Can Placebos Stop Diseases?

Placebos cannot stop cancer or health problems. **They** don't kill diseases. However, they can help with things like pain and sleep problems. Sometimes, when people think differently about medicine, their body may feel different. The placebo effect shows that the mind and body are closely connected.

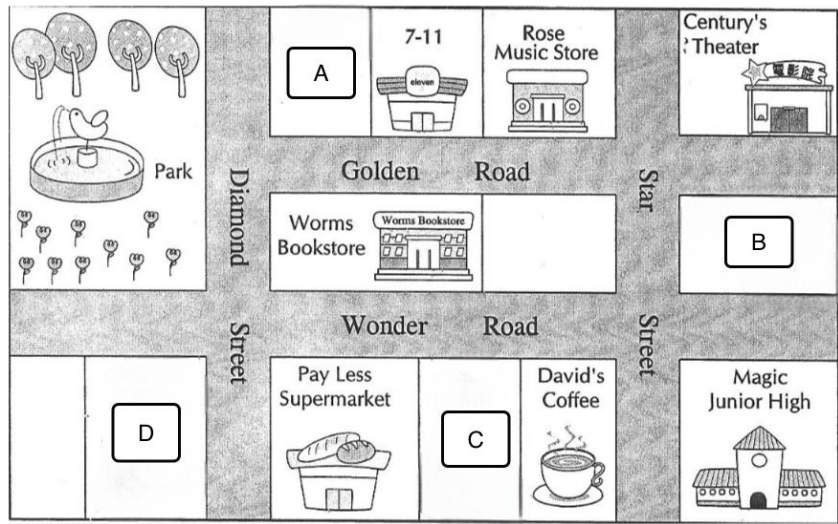
